To be Eligible to Take the Civil Service Written Examination for Beginning Level Position Peace Officer with the City of Edinburg Police Department, Applicants Shall:

- not be less than 21 years of age;
- be a high school graduate; or, have passed a General Educational Development (GED) test indicating high school graduation level with 12 semester hours credit from an accredited college or university. All police officers must be able to intelligently read and write the English language;
- have a valid Texas Driver License and satisfactory driving record;
- have completed and returned the documentation to the office of the Edinburg Civil Service Commission, by the deadline. No applications will be accepted after the deadline; and,
- meet the minimum standards set forth in the published notice and the established minimum qualifications in the position classification plan as adopted by the Civil Service Commission

A new examination may be given, depending on the needs of the Edinburg Police Department, at the end of the six (6) month or twelve (12) month period or sooner, if applicable.
